Tiebreaker #1: Record among tied teams in their head-to-head matchups

Week #2: Falcons 5, Eagles 3

Week #4: Eagles 4, Huskies 3

Week #6: Huskies 8, Falcons 5

All teams are 1-1 in head-to-head

Tiebreaker #2: Overall Records

If records are not identical (like they are in this example), the team with the most wins will win the championship, or the team with fewer wins will be eliminated and the remaining teams will go back to Tiebreaker #1 to determine championship.

Tiebreaker #3: Outcome versus Rank Order

vs. Broncos	11 - 6, +5, W	12 - 6, +6, W	13 - 7, +6, W
vs. Rockets	5 - 3, +2, W	6 - 4, +2, W	5 - 2, +3, W
vs. Bobcats	13 - 8, +5, W	10 - 0, +10, W	9 - 2, +7, W

All teams won all games vs. rank order, so we go to tiebreaker #4.

Tiebreaker #4: Total Goal Differential (G D)

The total goal differential for all three teams is +35, so we move to tiebreaker #5.

Tiebreaker #5: Goal Differential in each game vs. rank order

All teams have a +4 vs. Flashes, but the Falcons are eliminated with a +5 vs. Broncos. We then go back to head-to-head (Tiebreaker #1) with the Eagles and Huskies.

The Eagles win the League Championship on the Fifth Tiebreaker, with their 4-3 win over the Huskies in Week #4.
